



Content	Eligibility	Academic Requirements
Freshman	An applicant who is a non- Korean citizen and whose parents also do not have Korean citizenship	Completed (or will be completed prior to Admission) primary and secondary school either in or outside Korea
Transfer Sophomore		Meeting Freshman academic requirements plus: 2- or 3-year college graduate (i.e., Junior college degree) or at least 1-year of enrollment at a 4-year university and successful completion of at least 25% of the curriculum of a 4-year university
Transfer Junior		Meeting the Freshman academic requirements plus: 2- or 3-year college graduate (Junior college degree) or at least 2-years of enrollment at a 4-year university and successful completion of at least 50% of the curriculum of a 4-year university




