

2019 Invitation Program for Distinguished TOPIK Achievers

The Korean Government would like to invite active university students who have distinguished themselves on the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK)! This program is designed to provide its participants with an invaluable, enriching experience in Korea. Any individual who is eligible and interested may apply.

Program Period

Selected individuals will be invited to participate in our program in Korea over the course of 10 nights and 11 days, from **July 9th (Tuesday)** through **to July 19th (Friday)**.

Participant Numbers

One (1) individual will be selected **each** from **15 different countries**, for a **total of 15 participants**.

Hosting Organization

The **2019 Invitation Program for Distinguished TOPIK Achievers** will be hosted by the **National Institute for International Education (NIIED), Ministry of Education** located within the **Republic of Korea**.

Qualifications

All of the following qualifications must be met:

- Must be a current **undergraduate** university student in active studies
- Must have taken and successfully completed TOPIK within the last two years (March.1.2017.~Feb.28.2019)
- Must be able to communicate in Korean (conversational)

Responsibility of Expenses

NIIED: Round trip airfare, accommodations, meals, and traveler's insurance in Korea

Selected Participants: Cost of Visa Issuance, Transportation fare in his/her country, etc

Lectures	Korean History, Economics, Culture, etc.
